HB 57	Wildberger	Establishes the Registered Surgical Technologist Title Protection Act. Bill History: 04-28-09 H Referred to House Committee on House-Rules
HB 326	Sutherland Griesheimer	Revises the definition of "clinical social work" and prohibits public or private entities from using any title or abbreviation for identifying volunteers or employees as social workers unless licensed. Bill History: 05-05-09 H Truly Agreed to and Finally Passed (Vote: Y:152/N: 5)
HB 388	Cooper-155	Revises the definition of "professional counseling" and authorizes the State Committee for Professional Counselors to require certain licensed professional counselors to provide evidence of training. Bill History: 02-18-09 H Public hearing completed
HB 453	Roorda	Creates the Corrections Officer Training Fund, authorizes a \$5 surcharge to fund it, and requires corrections officers and jailers to receive at least 36 hours of training every three years. Bill History: 01-28-09 H Read second time
HB 536	Dixon	Authorizes the licensure of prescribing psychologists. Bill History: 04-29-09 H Set on the House Calendar
HB 679	Wasson	Establishes a limited license for a retired dentist to practice dentistry. Bill History: 03-25-09 H Voted do pass as substitute from committee on House-SC on Professional Regulation/
HB 750	Faith	Establishes requirements for the licensure of naturopathic physicians. Bill History: 04-08-09 H Voted do pass as substitute from committee on House-SC on Professional Regulation/
HB 851	Wasson	Changes the laws regarding the licensure of barbers and

cosmetologists.

 Bruns Modifies requirements for certain law enforcement personnel.

Bill History: 05-11-09 H Truly Agreed to and Finally Passed

SB 204 Goodman Creates licensing requirements for prescribing psychologists.

Bill History: 03-09-09 S Voted do pass from committee on Senate-Financial/Gov. Org. and Elections

SB 233 Cunningham Allows the State Board of Education to issue teacher certificates to certain individuals in the areas of banking and financial responsibility.

Bill History: 01-27-09 S Referred to Senate Committee on Senate-Education

SB 263 Mayer
 Wright Modifies the law relating to Second Capitol Commission, the Seismic Safety Commission and liability of volunteers during declared emergencies.

Bill History: 05-12-09 S Set on the Senate Calendar

SB 295 Scott Specifies that licensed professional counseling includes the diagnosis of mental, emotional, and behavior disorders and allows the committee for professional counselors to require certain education or training in diagnostic skills.

SB 296 Scott
 Sater Modifies laws regarding cemeteries and cemetery operators, physician assistants, the board for architects, professional engineers, professional land surveyors, and landscape architects, dental care professionals, nurses, pharmacy, and mental health benefit
